

# 6 county athletes win gold medals

## Five win titles in Class B meet

Individual performances highlighted the day for the county's Class B teams at the Class B state meet at Einstein. Magruder's Kendall Butler outleaped Howard's Samuel Harris to capture the 110 meter high hurdles at 14.2.

Damascus's Buddy Irby hurled the discus 150-1 to win that event by eight inches over Liberty's David Dailey.

A surprise to no one, Magruder's Andrew Bevan, the area leader in the pole vault, captured the boys' only other first place. Since the Penn Relays, where he placed fourth with a then-personal best 14-0, Bevan's been vaulting higher and higher each outing. He leads the area with the 14-9 he cleared two weeks ago in the county meet. His momentum slowed momentarily last week in the regionals, where he won at 14-0. Saturday, Bevan's top clearance was sub-par for him at 14-6, but a foot above the competition.

In the girls' meet, county participants could only muster two individual firsts, and they both belong to Einstein's Mary Bodnar. Bodnar won the 1600m in 5:19.1, a full 28 seconds ahead of North Carroll's Cindy Flannery.

Returning in the metric two mile, Bodnar again was barely challenged. She won in 11:36.2. Second place went to Aberdeen's Zenny Koehler, who crossed the finish line 22 seconds later.

Richard Palmer, Michelle Johnson, Wanda Evans and Lisa Henderson of Magruder teamed up for the fastest 800m relay of the day. Running a 1:45.8, the Colonels beat Great Mills time of 1:47.7.

## Herdt's a hit at AA tourney

Several county Class AA boys hit the peak of their outdoor track season at the right time — the state meet.

Kris Herdt of Whitman won the 1600m and 3200m, Springbrook's Nathaniel Lowen captured the gold medal in the discus, Gaithersburg's Charlie Gassaway took the long jump (and finished second in the triple jump) and Lance Fletcher of Blair won the 800m.

Old Mill ran off with both the boys and the girls team titles at the event, held at Annapolis High School. The Patriots outscored Bladensburg and Westminster in the boys, 67½-34. Friendly and Whitman also tied, scoring 33.

Old Mill's girls beat Suitland by almost 20 points, totalling 70 to the Rams' 51. High Point finished third at 40.

Gassaway, a 6-foot-1, 178-pound junior, established the pattern early for the county when he just missed winning the triple jump, his favorite event. His best jump, 46-6, is his personal record by almost four feet, but fell just five inches short of Meade's Claude Walker, who won in 46-11.

"I like the triple jump best," said Gassaway, the starting flanker and linebacker on Gaithersburg's football team in the fall. "I don't know, I guess because it takes more effort. I've got to work on stretching out the middle phase. I want to go fast and rush it to get down for a better push off. But you've got to take it easy."

In the long jump, Gassaway soared to 23-0. That jump beat his previous best by 1½ feet

## Sherwood and Kennedy do well

Six county athletes won gold medals and set records at the Maryland Class A track and field championships Friday.

But if it weren't for either Sherwood or Kennedy, a second place would have been the best any county athlete could muster.

Sherwood's Joe McGirr won the 1600m, finished second in the 3200m, teammate Smith won the discus (and finished third in shot put), another Warrior, Beth Hankins won the 1600m (and finished fifth in the 800m), her sister, Ginny topped the high jump with a state record.

Kennedy's Beth Jacobson walked away with the 3200m field, breaking her own state record and her teammate, Allison Armstrong's record in shot put.

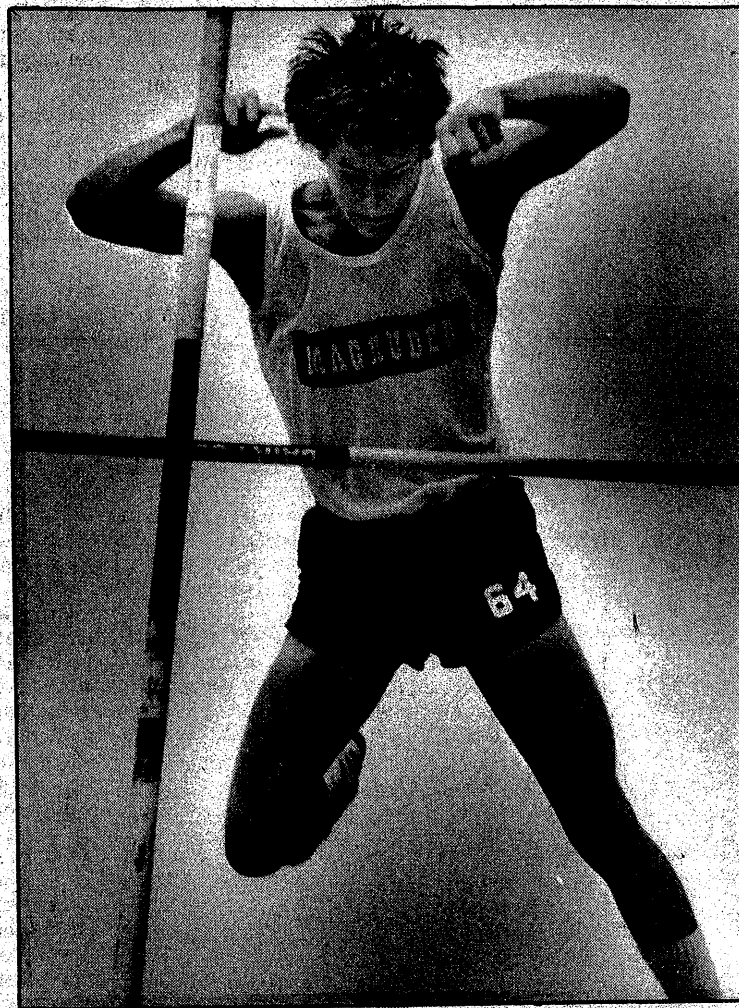
Central's boys and girls overran any other team, winning both team titles. Central compiled 106 points, with Northern a second at 39. Douglass was third at 36.

Central's girls had a little tougher fight to fend their state title. Trailing McDonough in the sixth event, a 1-2 finish in the 400m. Central an insurmountable lead to the Falcons won with 96 points to McDonough's 70. LaPlata followed at 50.

McGirr was going for the oft-tried and often unsuccessful distance double. He was way successful, winning his first race of the season, Kirk Young by three seconds. McGirr's lifetime-best 4:22.3; and losing to Young in the 3200m, 9:43.4-9:49.8.

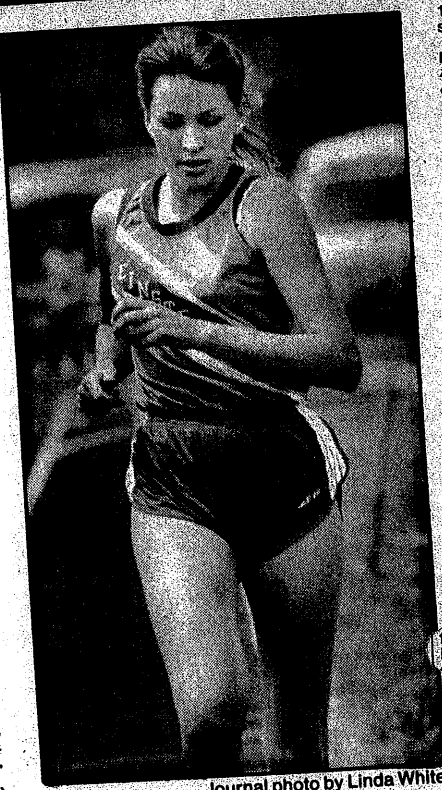

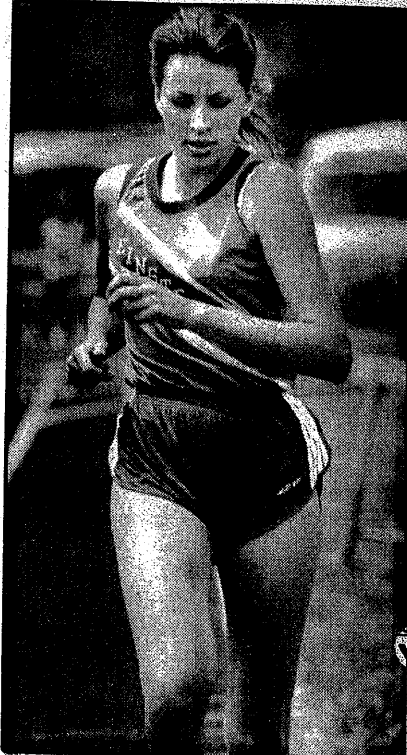

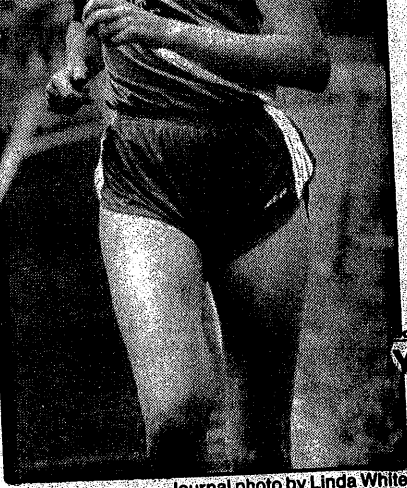
