# LASSITER, KARIE DUEL TO THE WIRE AT MOBIL MEET; GLYNN EASILY WINS GIRLS MILE; MOESER IS THE FASTER MASTER



(FAIRFAX, VA) Hitting 31- and 32-second laps on George Mason University's 200-meter indoor track, **Seneca Lassiter** of Lafayette High School (Williamsburg VA) raced stride-for-stride with **Sharif Karie** of West Springfield (VA) for 1750 yards, then barely outleaned him at the tape to win the Journal High School Boys' t the **Mobil Invitational Track & Field Meet**, Saturday, February 25, 1995. Lassiter ran 4:14.50 to Karie's 4:14.89. Lassiter's win at Mobil followed his 4:14.48 victory February 3 at New York City's Millrose Games.

**Sally Glynn** of Walter Johnson (Bethesda MD), easily outdistanced her competition in the High School Girls' Mile, cruising in unchallenged at 4:52.03. Glynn was also the girls' winner at the Millrose Games in 4:50.5.

**Chuck Moeser** of Herndon VA toppled a talented local field in the Sprint Masters Mile with a come-from-behind 4:35.53, with **Paul Zink** of Reston VA second in 4:38.11; **Paul Peterson** of Bethesda MD third in 4:38.92; and **Bill Rodgers** of Sherburne MA, four-time winner of Boston and New York Marathons and Cherry Blossom Ten-Miler, fourth in 4:43.22. Olympic Gold Medalist Frank Shorter finished in 4:59.67.

**Sprint Government Systems Division, Journal Newspapers**, and 40 other sponsors helped put together the three local miles, as part of the world-famous Mobil Meet. Matt Murray of Woodson High School, Bob Weiner of Captiol Hill Runners, and Jay Jacob Wind of DC Road Runners Club directed the three local one-mile events. Full results follow.
