2. There will be four divisions for 1996/97 unless three divisions can be formed and still allowing coaches the opportunity to attend invitationals. In the event of division ties, they will be broken by the score of all division wins. If a tie still exists, the opponents' totaled scores will be used with the highest score determining the champion.
3. Win-loss records submitted by coaches for the past two seasons will be used to determine divisions.
4. When two or more heats are run in a dual meet, it is recommended that the scoring heat be run first.

5. The pole vault starting height will be 8'. A competitor must clear 8' to score in a divisional meet. Girls pole vaulting will be contested in 96-97.
6. Results for divisional meets should be sent to Al Bellman at Watkins Mill for Divisions III and IV and to Greg Dunston at Walter Johnson for Divisions I and II.

COUNTY MEET

1. The County meet will be held at Magruder.
2. The Varsity B meet will be held at Walter Johnson.
3. Substitutions will be allowed in the county meets as long as the substitute meets the original criteria, either one entry per event, or one of three entries meeting the qualifying standards.
 - Substitutions will be made before the start of the meet.
 - Rank lists will be used for the 100, 200, high hurdles, and field events.
4. Pole vaulters will be weighed.

REGIONAL MEET

1. Possible two day 3A/2A combined meet in either Frederick or Carroll Counties.
2. Possible 4A regional meet held in county on a Wednesday beginning at 2:15 pm at either Magruder High School or Quince Orchard High School.

STATE MEET

1. Coaches recommended reassessing site for 1996-97.
2. If the state meet returns to Westminster High School, the following suggestions were made:
 - Increase female bathroom facilities.
 - Make telephones more accessible.
 - Check discus sector
3. Girls' pole vault will be added.
4. Vaulters will be weighed in at the state meet.
