What are we doing about the abuses in intercollegiate sports?

The American public has lost confidence in intercollegiate sports. It's a direct—and natural—response to media reports on everything from drug abuse to academic compromise. To be called a "student-athlete" is no longer an honor.

A small college of 1,200 students, Western Maryland boasts an unusually large sports program. We field 21 varsity sports and offer a dozen more at the club, intramural, and individual levels. Today, more than a third of our students compete on one, two, or even three teams.

Over the years, WMC has compiled a proven record for graduating *student-athletes*. We have produced what the reformists have only recently begun clamoring for—well-rounded, liberal arts-educated graduates.

As an NCAA Division III college—competing against Johns Hopkins, Franklin & Marshall, and Muhlenberg—we award no athletic scholarships. The College sets the same admission, academic, and personal standards for *all* students. The resulting statistics are interesting. Our student-athletes earn higher grade point averages than our non-athletes. Several have been admitted to our academic Honors Program, and each semester many are named to the Dean's list. A real source of pride: over the past seven years, more than 25 of our student-athletes have been nominated to Academic All-America teams.

Three-time All-America volleyball and softball star Nicky Pesik is now in medical school. And former Academic All-America and basketball standout Doug Pinto won an NCAA postgraduate scholarship to attend medical school. Today, he is a resident in internal medicine at Kettering Medical Center.

We may not win the national championship, but our student-athletes are earning some impressive titles of their own.

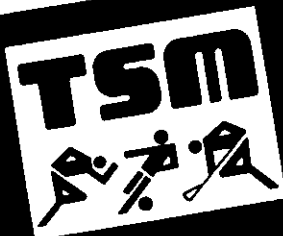

A word about conversions and automatic times . . .

Races were run in yards through 1979 and are converted to meters so they can be compared with the times in meters (from 1980 on). Times with 2 digits after the decimal are automatic times — 'Accutrack' times — and were recorded at the 1988 State AA Meet and the 1989 and 1990 meets. In order to compare:

COMPARING HAND TIME in YARDS to HAND TIME in METERS

100 yard time X 1.09 = 100 meter time
120 yard HH time X 1.0025 = 110 meter time
All others: yard time X .9942 = meter time

For a result in 2 decimal places, round decimal UP to next tenth of a second. **EXAMPLE** of 220 y hand time > 200 m hand time:
21.6 y X .9942 = 21.47472 m = 21.5 m (rounded up)

(100 y HAND time + .24) X 1.09 = 100 meter AUTOMATIC time
(120 y HH HAND time + .24) X 1.0025 = 110 meter AUTOMATIC time
(220 y or 330 y Hurdles HAND time + .24) X .9942 = 200 m or 300 m Hurdles AUTOMATIC time
(440 y or 440 y Relay HAND time + .14) X .9942 = AUTOMATIC meter time

COMPARING HAND TIME in METERS to AUTOMATIC TIME in METERS

HAND time + .24 for races less than 1 lap — 100, 200, HH, 300 H
HAND time + .14 for 1 lap races — 400, 400 Relay
Races more than 1 lap: just rank.

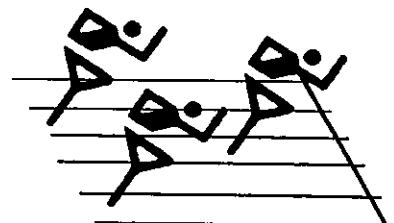
At the 1980 AA State Meet, Laurel's Myrtle Chester became the first athlete to win 4 individual events, capturing titles in the 100m HH (14.3), 300m H (44.5), LJ (17-0), and HJ (5-4). Myrtle competed for Tennessee as a pentathlete and heptathlete. She is presently assistant coach for the 4-time defending NCAA champions, LSU.



Tom Brosius of Springbrook is the only athlete to hold two individual boys' state records. His 64-6 1/2 in the SP and 184-10 DT remain the oldest individual records in state competition, dating back to 1968.



Bladensburg's Paula Hines, 1980, is the only girl to hold two individual state records. Her 11.7 in the 100m and 24.0 in the 200m were part of a great day, as she also anchored the state record 400m Relay (47.6) and 1600m Relay, ranked 3rd all-time (3:51.9)!

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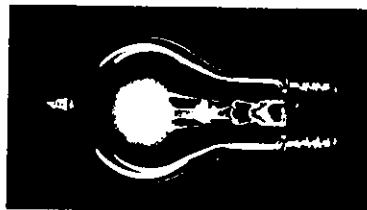
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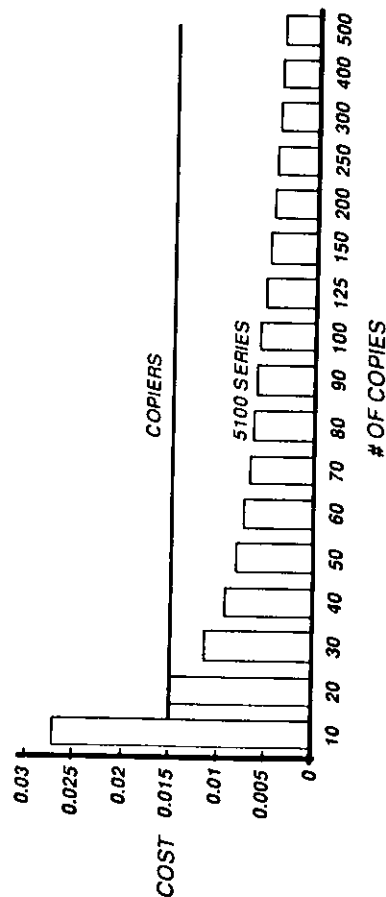


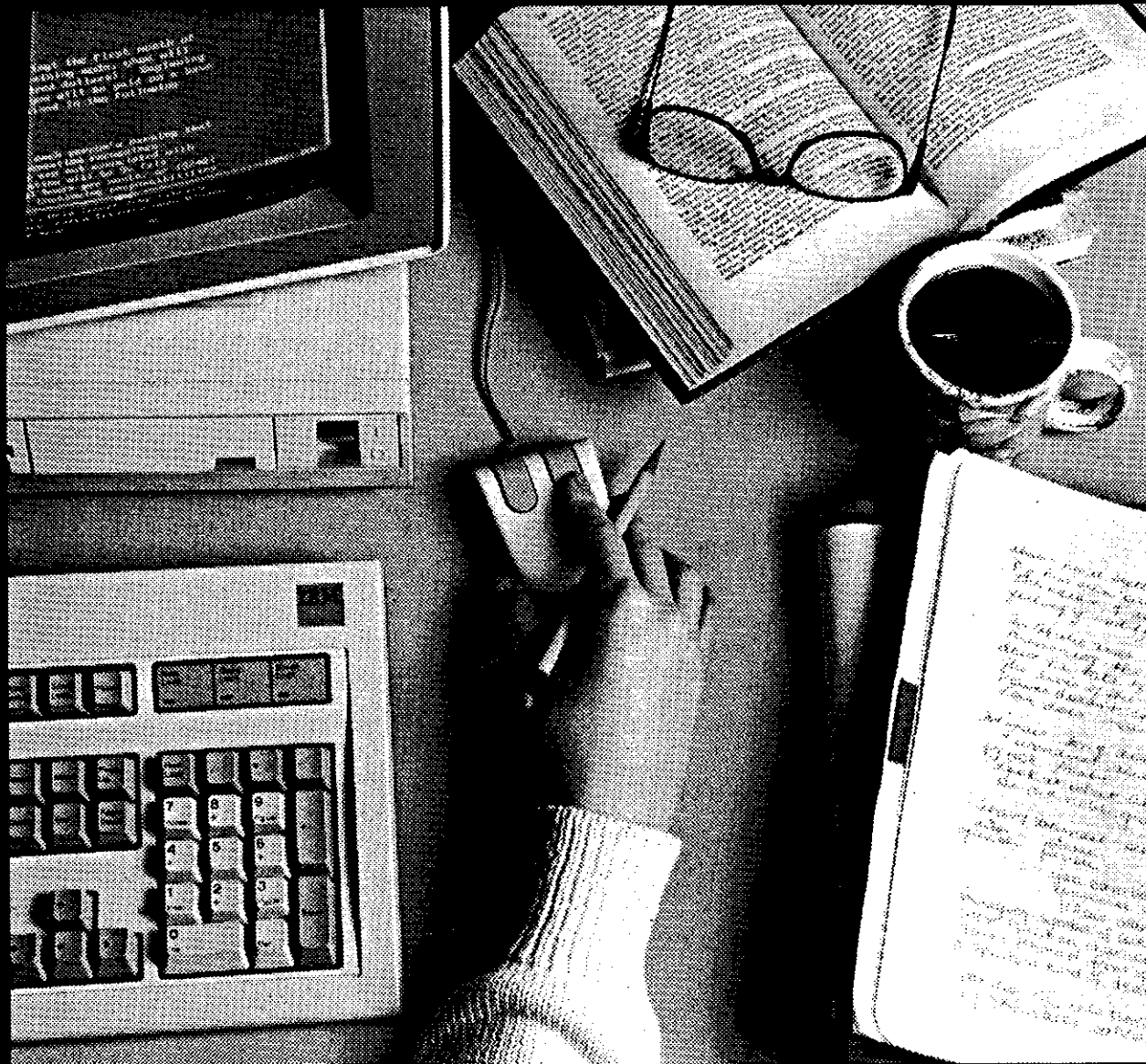
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
